Meeting was called to order at 10:01 A.M.

Edward Gorham made a motion to accept **minutes** of the December 8, 2009 meeting as written. Alfred Seymour seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS**

The 3 selectmen signed the Certificate of Commitment of Sewer User Rates.

Edward Gorham said that he would talk to Sonny Barry about a snowplowing complaint he received regarding the plowing of snow on McLaughlin Terrace. A resident contacted Ed and asked if the plowing could return to the way it was done in the past when the snow was put in the middle of the circle instead of dumped onto lawns and Ed said he would look into it.

Marjorie Gilman asked the Selectmen for an update on the trash situation on Maple Street which is still a problem since last she met with the selectmen in July. She told the Board that she has had to call Tibbetts repeatedly to pick up the trash across the street at the apartment building. Tibbetts removes the trash when they can get to it but there have been times when the tenants have parked in front of the dumpster and Tibbetts cannot get to it. There is open trash all around – not just in and on the dumpster. Peter Hanley said that if the owner was not going to take care of the trash then the Town would call to have the trash removed and bill the owner as was decided this summer. Peter also mentioned that Bob St. Pierre, the Code Enforcement Officer, had done what he could regarding the situation and that it was in the hands of the Town's attorney and that the attorney was supposed to be summoning the owner to court. Peter said that he would call John Larouche after the meeting to see how things are proceeding.

Marjorie Gilman also told the Board of Selectmen that there is a problem with people parking on Maple Street even though there is a parking ban in effect. She has been contacting Greg Lumbert to report them.

Edward Gorham made a motion to sign the agreement with Savings Bank for two credit lines, one for \$417,000 and one for \$25,000 with interest rates of 2.5%. Alfred Seymour seconded. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**

Gardiner Ambulance will no longer be sending our uncollectibles to their collection agency. Al made a motion to do some research to see how other area towns are going to handle this.

The board discussed Christmas bonuses for the office staff. Ed made a motion to give Lynn and Janet \$175.00 each and Raeleen \$150.00. Al seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**

Al made a motion to renew the Firefighter Volunteer Insurance. Ed seconded. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**

Al made a motion to adjourn at 11:23 A.M. Ed seconded. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**
