

An Ordinance to Adopt the 1981 National Fire Protection #101 Life Safety Code and The Revised Edition

Section 1: Purpose

The purpose of this ordinance is to promote the health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of the Town of Randolph and to help prevent the loss of life and injuries from fire and other elements.

Section 2: Definitions

- (A) Town: Town of Randolph, Maine
- (B) Shall: Is Mandatory
- (C) May: Is Permissive

Section 3: Specifications

- (A) To adopt the 1981 National Fire Protection #101 Life Safety Code and the revised edition. The newest edition shall supersede all previous editions.

Section 4: Enforcement

- (A) The Municipal Officers and/or their appointees, the Health Officer, Police Chief, Fire Chief, Building Inspector, and Code Enforcement Officer, shall act in all cases of violation of this ordinance by notifying, in writing the owner or leasor of the structure of the kind and nature of the violation and the correction of same if possible.
- (B) The Municipal Officers are charged with the prosecution for all violations of the provisions of this ordinance. In case such notices referred to in Section 4 (A), above, are not promptly complied with after receipt of said notices, the Municipal Officers may institute such actions or proceedings at law or in equity are proper to restrain, correct, or remove such violations.
- (C) Any person or corporation who violate any of the provisions of this ordinance or fail to comply within a reasonable period as determined by the Municipal Officers with any of the requirements thereof shall, upon conviction, be assessed a fine of not more than \$100.00 for each offense. Each day such violations continue shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 5: Conflicting Ordinances

- (A) Where the provision of this ordinance conflict with the provisions of any existing ordinance, the stricter provision shall prevail.

Section 6: Validity

- (A) Should any section or part of a section or any provision of this ordinance be declared by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such declaration shall not be deemed

to affect the validity of any other section, subsection, or other portions of this ordinance.

Section 7: Effective Date

(A) The effective date of this ordinance shall be the date this ordinance is enacted by the voters of the Town of Randolph
