Matt motioned to accept the minutes of 2/23/2021. Bob seconded the motion, **VOTE UNANIMOUS**

Payroll and Accounts Payable warrants were signed by all board members.

Abatements were discussed, Matt motioned to accept the recommendations of Bill Van Tuinen, Assessors Agent, Kirkpatrick for \$22,000.00, Tyler \$34,000.00, Morissette \$12,000.00 and Hinkley Trust \$43,800.00 assessed value. Bob seconded the motion, **VOTE UNANIMOUS**

Greg gave an update of issues on Stevens Avenue, asked about cost of solar farms building permit fees, (to be discussed later).

Art will be filling pot holes as soon as it warms up a bit. A discussion on snowplow complaints, the only complaint was the dump truck driver was going too fast. Art said that Sullivan Associates is in the process of updating the pumpstations on to Barber Road and that Hoyle Tanner will be doing a demo on March 3, 2021. On Belmont Avenue they have been given permission to remove cedar trees that will be in the way of construction. There will be 11 trees being removed in the project. Bids are due in 3/12/2021 by 2:00 pm for Belmont Avenue.

Lawn Mowing contract was discussed, Matt will prepare an ad it will be advertised on the Town Facebook Page, MMA and the Town Website.

Legal Services were discussed, it was decided to try to use MMA Legal more and to be sure that all work going to the Town attorney is motioned and has a time limit for results.

Mark asked Janet what the status of the Town issuing plates was, Janet explained that she is on probation for 6 months as the new Motor Vehicle Agent and no in person training has been scheduled for the New Level of Registrations. With the office being down one person and Janet and Jessica learning new positions, we are looking at July 2021 before we will start issuing plates.

Janet asked for Jessica's wages to be increased as she has become the Tax Collector along with her other jobs. Bob motioned to raise her pay by .50 an hour. Mark seconded the motion, **VOTE UNANIMOUS**

Next meeting will be March 16, 2021 due to the special election on march 9, 2021.

Bob motioned to adjourn the meeting. Matt seconded the motion, **VOTE UNANIMOUS**
