Meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. Payroll and accounts payable warrants were signed by the Board.

The Board received an update from Bob St. Pierre on the following items:

21 Kinderhook Street court case – waiting for the Judge to make a decision.

Bob recommended to the Board that they may want to **hire an engineer prior** to any demolition
Bob is reviewing the ordinances with regard **to junk and debris**

The Board discussed with Mr. St. Pierre adding an assistant CEO who would assist Bob with his work but they would not be paid until they were certified. They would be a back-up CEO.

Also discussed was locking the “plans” drawer in the outer office as some are missing.

Bob St.Pierre left the meeting.

Angie Ellis from Ellis Construction was at the meeting to discuss end-of-year planning for snowplowing contract. 3 yards of sand was collected from “rolled” ditches. The cul-de-sacs will be done this upcoming weekend. 30 yards of sand was collected on the State Roads (Routes 27 and 9). There will be further discussions about using liquid calcium next year when the plowing season nears. The idea of extending the plow contract was discussed with no decisions being made.

Street sweeping was discussed. They will be doing a pre-sweep on April 16th with a final sweep on May 14, 2016.

Cemetery by-laws were discussed. Angie has been reviewing as Sexton. Mark will be typing up by-laws for discussion and adoption at the next meeting possibly.

Angie left the meeting.

Matt made a motion to accept the **minutes of the March 29, 2016** meeting. Bob seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**

Art Forand discussed the State training he attended for the town and discussed upcoming public works projects on South Maple. Trimming trees will be approximately \$2800 with \$800 to take down a dead maple tree on the corner of Maple Street and Windsor.

Maine Local Roads will pay 90% of signs that they feel the town needs to have.

A new rear bumper was installed on the town truck for the cost of \$400.

Central Street work will be \$42,500 with 210 feet of pipe and 5 laterals.

Sweeping on Quigley Lane was discussed.

Bob Henderson made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Matt Drost seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**

Meeting was adjourned at 6:45 p.m. Minutes were taken by the Chairman of the Board and transcribed by the Town Clerk.
