Matt Drost made a motion to accept the **minutes** of the February 11, 2020 meeting. Mark Roberts seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**

A complaint on **Third Street** was discussed. A resident complained that the street was not being plowed wide enough to allow two way traffic. Public Works responded to the area and noted that there were cars parked on the street and told them that they would be towed if not moved. Greg also responded to the scene and told the homeowner that the car(s) needed to be moved.

Greg was also contacted about **42 Belmont Avenue**. He was asked about the possibility of a **subdivision** with this 4+ acre parcel. The Board told Greg that this would be a planning board issue and that the town has a Subdivision Ordinance.

Greg also received, as did the Board, a plan for the **proposed solar farm**. Mark took the Board's copy of the booklet home to review. Greg said that they have asked about fees and it is not clear what they will be or how they will be assessed.

Greg told the Board that he got a new radio for the police car as all radios have gone digital.

Matt Drost made a motion to **adjourn** the meeting. Mark Roberts seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.** Next regular meeting is Tuesday, February 25, 2020 @ 5:00 p.m.
