Meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. Mark Roberts could not attend the meeting.

Sonny James reported to the Board activity for the past week with Public Works. He responded to a water main break on Closson Street after being called by the Gardiner Water District. The water pipe had snapped but GWD fixed the issue. He asked when Art Forand was going to be back as Public Works Foreman but the Board is not sure. Art is on the agenda for March 13, 2018. Sonny and Ron put up the “posted roads” signs and Sonny asked if it would be okay with the Board if he got some materials for filling pot holes. The Board gave permission for this.

Sonny left the meeting at 5:18 p.m.

Cory Gero was on the agenda to speak to the Board about a possible donation from the town to the **Gardiner Cal Ripken League** which includes children from Randolph. They are in need of a new lawnmower to keep the field (Quimby) in shape and they are trying to take over the maintenance of Quimby from the City of Gardiner. He has been to Pittston and requested \$2,000 but they said that they would have to put it on their next town meeting warrant. Randolph is in the process of setting up budget meetings for the upcoming end of the fiscal year (June) and asked Mr. Gero if he could put something in writing and also attend one of the budget committee meetings most likely in April. Mr. Gero said that he would be more than happy to attend. They will inform him of the meeting date and time. He is also going to make the same request to West Gardiner and Gardiner. The Board also would put this request on the town meeting warrant and let the townspeople vote on it if the Budget Committee agrees.

Cory Gero left the meeting at 5:38 p.m.

Bob Henderson and Matt Drost viewed a video given to the Town Office by a resident of Elm Street regarding a complaint about the snowplowing. Angie Ellis was also shown the video. They felt that the issue was caused by a parked vehicle in the way and that Ellis Construction has permission to have vehicles towed if they are in the way. Nothing further will be done about this unless the resident comes to see the Board. Matt may speak to Angie about the issue.

Bob Henderson made a motion to accept the **minutes of the February 20, 2018** meeting. Matt Drost seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**

Bob and Matt signed the accounts payable and payroll warrants for the week.

Matt discussed briefly his recent attendance at the Small Community Forum and the discussions of sending more services out for RFP's including legal services and a few other things.

This week's MSAD 11 Board Meeting that was supposed to take place on Monday, February 26, 2018 was cancelled. This was supposedly going to be when the Board would take the final vote to close TC Hamlin School but apparently, they still did not have all the figures etc., needed for the vote.

Bob St. Pierre, Code Enforcement Officer gave the Board a recent document he is going to be using with respect to all cooking establishments in Town. This is a reporting form for disposal of **oil and grease** so that this does not go into our sewer system and cause issues. Matt reviewed and made some changes he felt were necessary. Lynn will give his edits to Bob.

Bob Henderson made a **motion to adjourn** the meeting. Matt Drost seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**

Meeting was adjourned at 6:07 p.m. The next regular meeting will be Tuesday, March 6, 2018. Matt Drost will be unable to attend that meeting.
