Mowing was discussed. Kevin Ashline's contract was discussed. Minor changes will be made since there are no complaints about the work he performs for the town. The contract is up and the Board will ask about the gas prices being down and whether or not he can do a little better with the new contract.

Mark will be in touch with Kevin.

Peter is asking for a letter from the Town to Borrego Solar and the delay with regard to the social distancing and whether or not a public meeting can be held virtually.

Matt asked Peter whether or not the Planning Board can approve the project with a variance to the Land Use without the need for a public hearing and special town meeting. Pete does not think this is possible. Decisions will have to be made on how to proceed. There is a deadline of April 17, 2020 but the Town is not sure whose deadline this is.

Pete will contact MMA legal about the issue.

Plowing and sweeping contracts are up so there was discussion about changes if any being made to the proposal for the next contract. The contractor did a good job.

The timeline on this should be as follows: pre-bid after May 1<sup>st</sup> with award of the contract by June 15, 2020.

Pete brought up posted roads and when they will become unposted. Hallowell and Augusta discussed waiting until the end of the month so the Town will wait until then also.

Clark Street was discussed. That is just going to be shimmed. Klienfelder recommended shimming and reconstructing a culvert along Middle Street. It does go under Clark and Belmont also and should be re-habbed. Bob suggested curbing and catch basins this will keep the water off the edge of the pavement.

Peter Coughlan left the meeting.

Matt is waiting for a phone call from Brent Hall from Kennebec Savings about loan for road works.

Hoyle Tanner did not come to do the night-sticking – they came to check out the manholes but they have yet to put in the meters or do the night-sticking. After checking there appears to be no infiltration from the Mattson Complex.

Bob Henderson made a motion to accept the minutes of the March 31, 2020 meeting Mark Roberts seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**
