Discussion on the rate of pay for the Animal Control Officers. Matt motioned to pay the ACO \$14.00 per hour plus mileage until they become certified, once certified they will make \$16.00 per hour plus mileage, Mark seconded the motion, **VOTE UNANIMOUS.**

Art informed the Board that nothing had been done in the cemeteries, the contract didn't start until May 1, 2021, the cemeteries are going to need attention due to the grubs killing the grass all over and the roads need repairing. Art asked if the funds could come out of the Perpetual Care funds, Janet will contact Angie Ellis the cemetery sexton, to find out.

An Elm Street resident wants no parking signs on upper Elm Street, it was discussed and decided there was no safety issue warranting the signs.

Art gave an update on Barber Road Pump Stations, everything is working good and all the numbers are matching. The Electro Scan will start May 27, 2021 on Water & Kinderhook Street and the cross-country lines.

Ingrid Stanchfield gave an update on the Boys & Girls Club they are requesting \$11,250.00 the same as last year. They are also requesting a Capital Gift to go towards the building of the new Club. The Board will discuss this at their budget workshop.

Greg gave an update on complaints of possible junkyards around town and updated the board on the reported dog bite on May 2, 2021 that was reported to happen at the Randolph Take-Out.

Solar Farm building permit fees were discussed possibly .07 cents per square foot plus \$50.00 permit fee.

The Board approved the extension of the Planning Board approval of the Solar Farm Application.

Greg suggested that the Town adopt an Odor Ordinance, he will send a draft ordinance to the Board

The Driveway Entrance Permit was reviewed by the MDOT for the new Fire Station.

Bob motioned to adjourn the meeting. Matt seconded the motion, **VOTE UNANIMOUS**
