Meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m.

Peter Hanley stated that he felt the Town Office should be closed the day after any major election. Janet said that the office would be opened later in the day during these times.

The warrant for Town Meeting was discussed. Mr. Goodall has been retained to serve as moderator at the meeting.

Bob Henderson said that he had called Attorney Larouche twice but had heard nothing from him about the fireworks ordinance.

Janet asked the Board to look over all the articles for any errors in spelling, grammar and punctuation etc., and to make a decision on Article 13 regarding the general fund. She said that there is \$323,000 in the general fund. Revenue sharing went down to \$108,000 which is an estimate.

When the article for changing the municipal election comes up at Town Meeting, they will ask Michael Carrie to explain it. The school board members were asked if they were behind this and they said they were.

**Article 13** – Peter Hanley asked the treasurer's opinion on this. She said anywhere from \$275,000 to \$300,000 to be taken from the general fund. Ed suggested \$295,000.00. Peter Hanley made a motion to take \$295,000 out of the general fund. Ed Gorham seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**

It was discussed when the Board members will meet to sign the final warrant so that the town report can be taken to the printer on Monday morning.

Bob suggested that the board meet at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, July 13, 2012 to sign the warrant.

Ed made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Peter Hanley seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**
