Meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m.

The Tax Collector presented scenarios to the Board that ranged from 15.36 and 16.12. She presented 5 different alternatives. If 15.58 is selected this means that the tax rate will go up one half a mil. This would go up approximately \$.50 per one thousand dollars.

Ed made a motion to set the tax rate at **15.58** . Peter Hanley seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**

Bob reported on the closing he attended the day before on the property at 104 Kinderhook Street. Peter made a motion to abate the property taxes on 104 Kinderhook Street. Ed seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.** Bob said that there were two items left behind that the family would like to have. There was a hutch and a piece of granite and the Board agreed that it would be okay for them to come in and get them.

Janet asked if the town would be willing to pay for life insurance for her (\$10.80 per month) since she is not going to be taking the health insurance.

Peter made a motion to pay the life insurance (through MMA) for Janet from the Wastewater Account. Ed seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**

Ed made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Peter seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**
