The meeting started at 5 pm, and immediately went into executive session per 1 M.R.S.A §405(6)(E) to discuss an abatement. Board returned from executive session at 5:10 pm. Matt made the **motion to accept abatement agreement** 2016-P2 in the amount of \$939.32, Bob Henderson seconded the motion. **VOTE - UNANIMOUS.**

Board members signed accounts payable and payroll warrants.

Art discussed the paving on School Street and the quote for \$5200. The driveway work is beginning the week of 09/12/16 and is estimated to cost \$15,000. The lot will be striped a week after the top coat is laid to allow asphalt to weather. Art had one itemized crack sealing bid, and is going to the second vendor to get an itemized list and target the roads that can be saved from crack filling, and not work on the roads that are being replaced anyway. All of these projects are targeted for completion this fall. Art left the meeting at 5:45 p.m.

Ron was at the meeting to discuss the **free smoke detector program with the America Red Cross**. Eric from the Red Cross will be at the meeting October 11th to discuss this. Installation is planned for November 12th, and Ron needs volunteers and also asked the selectmen to be available as well.

Ron also wanted to discuss the fire truck that could be available for loan from Chelsea. This would require that we put one of our tanker trucks in storage, perhaps in Farmingdale as they have an open bay with heater storage. Ron is going to do some more research and get back to the board with a plan. Ron left the meeting at 5:52 p.m.

Bob Henderson made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Matt Drost seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**

Meeting was adjourned at 5:53 p.m. Next regular meeting is Tuesday, September 20, 2016 at 5:00 p.m. Minutes were taken by Selectman Matt Drost. Meeting was also recorded.
