In attendance, Bob, Mark, Matt, Art, Sonny at 5:15, Greg at 5:15.

Meeting started at five, Matt Drost made a motion to accept the **minutes** of the October 4, 2016 meeting as read, seconded by Bob, **unanimous**.

Sonny arrived at 5:15 to discuss an issue with the valves at the Water Street pump station. Sonny received a call on Sunday afternoon and responded to find an issue with the drains. Stevens was called in Monday and Grease was found on the float station and Ted Berry was called Monday to remove the grease and dirt from the floats. Mark suggested that Ted Berry come three or four times a year instead of twice and they are currently scheduled for. Sonny left the meeting by 5:20.

Greg discussed items stored behind the fire station that belonged to public works, and noted that it would be difficult to plow with the items that were currently being stored there. It was discussed with Art what could be done with the items from behind the fire station and it was decided that the sewer rodder would be disposed of, the trailer find a new home, and the manhole cover rings and manhole covers would be stored to the left side of the fire station that is not plowed. Greg left the meeting at 5:33.

Art discussed the catch basin project on **Meadowview Drive** which has been completed, and wondered if the grease issues could be from other household products being drained into the sewer system.

Art has Scheduled Water St., flushing for 28 October.

Art mentioned a complaint from the resident at 95 Kinderhook St. about their culvert which has heaved. The selectmen discussed that because this is not the result of public works, and that it could not be covered by the town.

The final bills have come in for the paving of the town office parking lot, totaling a little \$17,020. This amount paid from the building and lands account, but the catch basin work that

was completed on Kinderhook Street will be paid for from the capital improvement roads account.

Matt Drost made a **motion to adjourn** the meeting at 6:06, seconded by Bob, **unanimous vote**.
