Meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m.

A representative from **Sun Sun Restaurant** was present for the liquor license hearing renewal. The public hearing was opened and hearing no objections, Peter Hanley made a motion to sign the renewal for BLQ Corporation (Sun Sun Restaurant) Ed Gorham seconded the motion. **VOTE-UNANIMOUS.**

Hearing was closed at 5:20 p.m.

Delsa Mock was recognized by the Board. She stated that she protested that the health insurance was passed after she felt that it was voiced at the Town Meeting that the taxpayers did not want it to pass.

Bob Henderson gave all present a breakdown of what the Selectmen did with the amount approved in Article 13. They were able to purchase the health insurance for 10 months by adjusting some of the amounts in this article.

The Budget Committee recommended the amount of \$285,000 and the list shows what the Board did to include the health insurance and stayed within the \$285,000. He explained that part of the money was taken from the Wastewater System to pay for this. The amount of \$7500 for 9 months of insurance coverage was the final amount with some being taken out of the Wastewater System.

Donald and Theresa Chicoine were recognized. They were upset with the fact that Health Insurance was given and the way it was done. He asked to see the plans offered and the one chosen. This information will be available at the next meeting.

Peter Hanley made a motion to accept the **minutes** from **the July 24, 2012, August 7, 2012 & August 17, 2012.** Ed Gorham seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**

The Board went over a new **personnel policy** for town employees (excluding office staff) with John Crocker. This will be signed at this meeting and become policy. John had no questions or comments. It was discussed whether or not **both** Barber Road and Lincoln Streets could be done this fiscal year. The Board and John agreed that Barber Road would be done first and Lincoln Street if there was enough money left. John feels that both may be possible.

The Board signed two letters to the **State of Maine and Kennebec Sheriff's Department** regarding the use of their **dispatch services** when the town implements a police vehicle and radios. Bob said that he had

talked with Greg about when we will be getting a vehicle for this purpose and he said that he has looked and there only two available at this time.

At 6:00 p.m. **Sonny Barry** entered the meeting. He attended at the request of the Board to update the **snowplow/sanding/sweeping contracts**. The contracts were signed and Bob asked that Sonny provide the Board with some facts regarding how much sand and salt was used this past winter. He said that he tripled the salt this past winter. Sonny said he will give them that information. Sonny Barry left the meeting at 6:10 p.m.

Bob Henderson opened up the floor for **Public Comment**. Comments were made on the health insurance issue and the procedures of the Board and Budget Committee.

Peter Hanley made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Ed Gorham seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**

Meeting was adjourned at 6:35 p.m. Next meeting is Tuesday, September 4, 2012 @ 5:00 p.m.
