

An Ordinance Relating to Depositing Snow in Town Streets and Ways

Be it ordained and enacted by the Selectmen of the Town of Randolph, County of Kennebec, and State of Maine.

Section 1. That no person shall plow, push, shovel, dump, or otherwise move snow and ice into, or deposit within, the right-of-way of any street, highway, square or thoroughfare within the Town of Randolph.

Section 2. That in case of neglect to properly remove the same, said snow and ice shall be removed by the Town of Randolph, the expense of said removal to be paid by the person so neglecting.

Section 3. That any person found guilty of violating any provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a penalty of not more than \$100.00 for each offense.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately.

Hereof fail not and make due returns of this Warrant with your doings hereof on or before the hour of said meeting.
