The estimate for the tree removal on Middle/School Streets from Brownies Landscaping is \$11,000.00, Mark told Art to get it down next week. Flushing of Barber Road, Birmingham Road and Maureen

Avenue is going well. The utility trailer for the speed sign was picked up, Danny Nadeau will be fabricating a frame to fit the trailer.

Matt motioned to accept the snow plow contract for the Town properties with L & L Services for the 2021-2022 season. Bob seconded the motion, **VOTE UNANIMOUS**

Matt motioned to commit the sewer rates for June 15, 2021 billing in the amount of \$71,253.54. Bob seconded the motion, **VOTE UNANIMOUS**

Matt motioned to adjourn the board meeting and go to a budget meeting and then meet with the Budget Committee at 6:30 pm. Bob seconded the motion, **VOTE UNANIMOUS**
