Meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m.

Art informed the Board that he is all set to board up the Rausch residence tomorrow.

There have been some reported issues with mail delivery on Fairview Avenue due to the construction. Art is going to talk to the postmaster about this as residents have been told by the postal service that they will only receive mail deliveries on Saturdays during the construction. Art said that it is clear that emergency vehicles, postal trucks and school buses are made able to get through so he does not know why mail delivery is affected in this way.

Art is having a meeting in the morning on the paving in town. He will have the paving company pave the base, curbing and surface on School and Fairview at the same time which will save money.

Attorney Larouche presented the Board with an Order and Notice of Municipal Hearing on a Dangerous Building at 34 Windsor Street. After working on the formatting, the Board members signed and the Clerk attested to the Order. This will now be published in the local newspaper for 3 consecutive Saturdays, beginning on October 31, 2020. The hearing will then take place at 5 p.m. on Tuesday, November 17, 2020.

John will have a sheriff in Sagadahoc County serve the judgment on Mr. Rausch at the facility where he resides.

Matt Drost made a motion to accept the **minutes of the October 13, 2020** meeting. Bob Henderson seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**

The Board signed a Certificate of Ownership for a cemetery plot

Janet Richards asked the Board if we could have Greg Lumbert and Autumn Schmidt present for the entire day in their capacities as Police Officers for the Town of Randolph at the election on November 3, 2020. She suggested they be paid an hourly rate of \$20 per hour for their services. This is recommended for this election by the Secretary of State's Office.

Matt Drost made a motion to pay Greg and Autumn \$20 per hour on November 3, 2020 to serve at the polling station. Bob Henderson seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**

Janet also asked the Board if they had done any further work or read the paperwork on the retirement plans and they have not. They will be looking at this soon.

Matt Drost made a motion to **adjourn** the meeting and go into a work session ZOOM conference with the designers of the Fire Station. Mark Roberts seconded the motion. **VOTE – UNANIMOUS.**

Meeting was adjourned at 5:55 p.m. Next regular meeting is Wednesday, November 4, 2020 @ 5 p.m. The meeting is on Wednesday due to Tuesday being election day.
